



Heliport Conditional Determination

Heliport Proposal, Kaikoura Helicopters Hanger Heliport

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 157 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Kaikoura Helicopters Limited a Notice of the Kaikoura beachfront Heliport Proposal, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representative groups and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study I am satisfied that the proposed action will not adversely affect the safety of objects, but may impact the safe and efficient use of airspace, aerodrome traffic circuits, and persons or property on the ground.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

CONDITIONAL DETERMINATION

in respect of the Notice of Proposal. The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. Kaikoura Helicopters must coordinate with the Whale Watchers Kaikoura Users Group to establish procedures for operating from the heliport within the Kaikoura MBZ. The procedures must be accepted by all stakeholders and included in the Kaikoura Airspace Memorandum of Understanding;
2. Kaikoura Helicopters is to publish the heliport, arrival and departure procedures in the AIPNZ in accordance with AC139-9. Kaikoura helicopters is responsible for ensuring the AIPNZ is updated to contain all information relevant to procedures for air operations at the heliport and within the Kaikoura MBZ;
3. All operators using the Heliport must comply with the agreed procedures contained in both the AIPNZ and Memorandum of Understanding;
4. Kaikoura Heliport is to ensure that the design and layout of the Heliport complies with standard design requirements provided in AC139-8 – Heliports. This includes but is not limited to establishing the obstacles around the heliport that infringe the AC139-8 surfaces and mitigating these if required.
5. In addition to the design requirements provided in AC139-8 – Heliports, Kaikoura Helicopters is to install fencing with signage around the perimeter of all operational areas of the heliport, and install a Windsock.

The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder

This conditional determination shall become void on 18th May 2019.
