

## **Heliport Conditional Determination**

### **Aerodrome/Heliport Proposal, Onetangi Heliport**

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 157 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Michael John Haines, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Auckland Regional Rescue Helicopter Trust a Notice of Heliport Proposal, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representative groups and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study I am satisfied that the proposed action will may adversely affect the safety of persons or property on the ground, but will not impact the safe and efficient use of airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

#### CONDITIONAL DETERMINATION

in respect of the Notice of Proposal. The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The heliport is constructed to the safety design standards published in CAA Advisory Circular AC139-8.
- During helicopter operations, safeguards are to be in place to prevent:
  - inadvertent entry of animals, unauthorised persons or vehicles to the helipad area; and
  - to provide reasonable protection of persons and property from helicopter rotor wash.

This conditional determination shall become void on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 2014.
