

## Heliport Conditional Determination

### Heliport Proposal, Poronui Lodge Heliport

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 157 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Poronui Lodge a Notice of Heliport Proposal, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representative groups and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study I am satisfied that the proposed action will not adversely affect the safe and efficient use of airspace, but may adversely affect aerodrome traffic circuits, the safety of persons or property on the ground or be affected by man-made or natural objects.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

#### CONDITIONAL DETERMINATION

in respect of the Notice of Proposal. The following conditions are specific to this Determination:


1. Poronui lodge must develop procedures to ensure conflict between the nearby aerodrome and the proposed heliport is minimised. These procedures must be communicated effectively to all helicopter and fixed wing operators; and
2. All operations at Poronui lodge heliport should maintain a listening watch on the appropriate radio frequency within the Kaimanawa Common Frequency Zone, and broadcast their intentions within the vicinity of the heliport; and
3. Poronui lodge is to ensure that the design and layout of the heliport complies with the standard design requirements provided in AC139-8 – Heliports; and
4. In addition to the design requirements provided in AC139-8 – Heliports, Poronui lodge it to install fencing with signage around the operational areas of the heliport that separates the lodge accommodation area with the heliport operational area, and install a windsock; and
5. Helicopter operations on the departure and approach paths to/from the FATO must also be made in accordance with CAR Part 91.127 (d)(2) and 91.127 (d)(3); and
6. Poronui lodge is to provide CAA with an annual report of traffic movement data for Poronui lodge heliport, in accordance with CAR Part 139.505 (a).

*The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder*



This conditional determination shall become void on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2019.
