



**Notice of proposal for construction of heliport**  
**Alpine Helicopters**  
**Cascade Cove Barge**  
**45 48 39.6 S 166 35 1.46 E**

The Civil Aviation Authority has received notification from Alpine Helicopters of a Proposal notifying an anticipated increase in activity for the Cascade Cove Barge Heliport at Cascade Cove; Civil Aviation Rule Part 157.5 (3) *increase the use of an established aerodrome or heliport restricted to VFR operations to more than 7 days in any 30 consecutive day period.*

Pursuant to Civil Aviation Rule 157.9, the Director of Civil Aviation is conducting an Aeronautical Study to consider the effects of the proposed action. In particular, the Aeronautical Study shall consider the following:

- The effect the proposed action would have on existing or contemplated aerodrome traffic circuits of neighbouring aerodromes.
- The effect the proposed action would have on existing and projected airspace uses.
- The effect the proposed action would have on the safety of persons and property on the ground.
- The effect the existing or proposed man-made objects and natural objects within the affected area would have on the proposed action.

In accordance with Civil Aviation Rule 157.9(b) the Director invites interested parties to make submissions concerning the proposal. Submissions should quote Work Request 23/157/01 and be addressed to:
