

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Watts And Hughes Ltd

Crane at 55 Percy Cameron St, Avalon Lower Hutt

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Watts And Hughes Ltd, notification of intention to construct a 20 metre high crane at a site in Avalon, Lower Hutt, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane is to be equipped with an obstacle light located at the highest point of the crane, in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule part 77, Appendix B. The light must be operational at all times that the crane is in use or above 15 metres AGL; and
- 2. Watts and Hughes construction must coordinate with Avalon Studios Itd, the heliport operator of Avalon Heliport, to develop procedures that ensure the risk to flight operations is minimised, and also publish a NOTAM advising pilots of the crane hazard: and
- 3. Watts and Hughes construction must advise CAA once the crane has completed operations.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 15th September 2018 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
