

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: H Troon NZ Limited

Cranes at Westgate Shopping Centre, Auckland

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from H Troon NZ Limited, notification of intention to construct and operate a 40 metre high crane at Fred Taylor Drive, Westgate, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane must be fitted with obstacle lighting in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule part 77, Appendix B. Lighting must be operational at all times; and
- 2. H Troon NZ Limited must abide by the conditions specified by RNZAF Base Auckland, and any additional conditions that are imposed by RNZAF Base Auckland during the execution of the project; and
- CAA must be notified when crane operations cease at the end of the project.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 24th October 2018 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
