

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: J D Rigging Services Limited-Tower Crane at Wellington East Girls College

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from JD Rigging Services Limited, notification of intention to operate a 24 metre crane at the Wellington East Girls College until April 2018, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane must be equipped with a flashing red obstacle light mounted at the highest available point on the crane in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B; and
- 2. The CAA is to be notified that the crane has been dismantled at the completion of the crane operation.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 28th day of September 2017 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 31st day of August 2018.
