

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Hawkins Construction Ltd Mobile Crane Unit for New Wellington Control Tower

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Hawkins Construction Ltd, notification of intention to operate a mobile crane in conjunction with the construction of the new ATC control tower for Wellington Airport, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane must be equipped with an operating red flashing hazard at all times that it is extended above the OLS at Wellington Airport;
- 2. Wellington International Airport Limited and Wellington ATC are to coordinate crane activity times as required;
- 3. Crane activity is to be advised by NOTAM or AIP SUPP;
- 4. The CAA is to be notified of the final cessation of the crane operation.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 17th day of February 2017 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
