

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: CBC Construction Ltd All Terrain Mobile Crane Hobsonville Point

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from CBC Construction Ltd, notification of intention to operate a 72m high Mobile Crane at Hobsonville Point, Hobsonville, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane is to be equipped with a high intensity obstacle light, located at the highest point of the crane in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B. The light must be operational at all times; and
- 2. The crane operator must inform the CAA when the crane is no longer in use and is dismantled; and
- 3. The Operational Procedure and Conditions agreed between CBC construction and the NZDF, and supported by Airways, must be used at all times the crane is in use.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 5 April 2018 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
