



NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Icon Co Pty NZ Limited Crane for Pacifica Tower 10-12 Commerce St Auckland

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Icon Co Pty NZ Limited, notification of intention to operate a 227 metre high crane at a site at Commerce St, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is to be equipped with a high intensity obstacle light, located at the highest point of the crane in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B. The light must be operational at all times; and
2. The crane operator must inform the CAA when the crane is no longer in use and is dismantled.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 29 March unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
