

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Pinnacle Rigging 2015 Ltd, Crane at 32 Raumati Road Raumati Beach

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Pinnacle Rigging 2015 Ltd, notification of intention to operate a 49.5 metre crane at a construction site at Raumati Road, Raumati Beach, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane must be fitted with obstacle lighting in accordance with CAR Part 77, Appendix B; and
- 2. The operator of the crane must be in constant communication with the Airways Flight information Service at Paraparaumu prior to, during, and at the end of all such work, to allow emergency lowering of the Crane boom; and
- 3. The operator of the crane must abide by the conditions specified by KCAHL, and any additional future conditions that are imposed during the execution of the project; and
- 4. The crane must be NOTAMed, including information on the penetration of the VSS; and
- 5. The CAA must be notified of the removal of the crane at the end of the project.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 14 October 2018 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
