

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Naylor Love Auckland Limited-Crawler Crane Long Bay Auckland

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Naylor Love Auckland Limited, notification of intention to construct and operate a 89 metre high crawler crane at Long Bay, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane is to be equipped with an obstacle light located at the highest point of the crane, in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B;
- 2. The crane operator must liaise with RNZAF Base Auckland operations to issue an applicable NOTAM for the period of the crane operations;
- 3. The crane operator must inform the CAA when the crane is no longer in use and is dismantled.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on the 12th day of June 2018 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on the 16th day of November 2019, or on the date that the proposed crane operation is abandoned, whichever is earlier.
