

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: BCD Group Limited- Tower Structure Pukeroa Road Waitomo

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Nicholas George John Officer, Acting Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from BCD Group Limited, notification of intention to construct a 75 metre high lattice tower at Pukeroa Rd, Waitomo,, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The structure is to be equipped with a red medium intensity obstacle light, located at the highest point of the structure in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B. The light must be operational at all times; and
- Aeropath Ltd are to be notified of the tower's location, so that the symbol for a lighted tower can be added to the approach charts for Te Kuiti Hospital Heliport, and the applicable Visual Navigation Charts.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 10th June 2019 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 10 December 2020.
