



NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: CPB Contractors - Crane for Matapihi Road-Girven Road Roundabout

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from CPB Contractors, notification of intention to install 972 stone columns by crane, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane and drill rig are to be equipped with medium intensity obstacle lights, located at the highest points of the crane and the drill rig in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B. The light must be operational at all times; and
2. The crane and drill rig is lowered below the 1:50 gradient take off climb surface OLS (22m above ground level) outside of daylight hours or when the crane is not in use; and
3. CPB Contractors must comply with the procedures put forward by Tauranga Airport at all times, and any other conditions imposed by Tauranga Airport during the crane and drill rig operations; and
4. CPB Contractors ensure Tauranga Airport has issued NOTAM's advising of both the crane and drill rig operations and new Runway Operational Data as applicable; and
5. CPB Contractions must advise the CAA when the crane and rill rig is no longer in use and is dismantled.

The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 11 April 2019 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
