

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Calder Stewart Plant Limited-Crane at 150 Hereford St Christchurch

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Calder Stewart Plant Limited, notification of intention to construct and operate a tower crane at 150 Hereford Street, Christchurch until April 2017, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane must have an obstruction light as specified in Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B, fitted to the highest point of the crane and it must operate at all times;
- 2. The CAA is to be advised when the crane is dismantled.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 9<sup>th</sup> day of August 2016 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 11th day of January 2018.
