

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Smith Crane And Construction Ltd- Luffing Tower Crane at Alexander Park Auckland

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Smith Crane And Construction Ltd, notification of intention to operate tower cranes at a building site at Alexandra Park, Epsom, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane must be fitted with obstacle lighting in accordance with CAR Part 77, Appendix B. (Conspicuous marking of the crane and equipped with a red flashing light at the highest available point of the crane;
- 2. The CAA must be notified of the removal of the cranes at the end of the project.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on the 6th day of January 2017 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 6th day of January 2018.
