

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 12 Hereford Street, Christchurch.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Cook Brothers Construction Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane at 12 Hereford Street, Christchurch conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. Due to the proximity of the crane to Christchurch Hospital Heliport, Cook Brothers Construction Limited is to notify CDHB (George.Schwass@cdhb.health.nz) of the operation of the crane; and
- 2. Cook Brothers Construction Limited is to advise the CAA, Quote 22/77/49 (aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) and CDHB when the crane operating at the Hereford Street site has been lowered and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 1^{5th} April 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 15th October 2023 or when the crane is lowered and no longer in use.
