

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 10 Alpha Street, Te Aro, Wellington.

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from CMP Construction NZ Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane at 10 Alpha Street, Te Aro, Wellington, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is to be lit with an appropriate obstacle light as stated in the proposal; and
2. The crane is not to exceed a maximum height of 95m AGL; and
3. CMP Construction NZ Limited is to advise the CAA (Quote 23/77/27 - aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane is finally lowered and no longer in use at the Alpha Street site.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 3rd April 2023 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 10th September 2024.
