

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 2 Brunswick Street, Queenstown

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Cook Brothers Construction Limited, notification of intention to erect a crane structure at 2 Brunswick Street, Queenstown, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane is not to exceed a maximum height of 65m above ground level (AGL) at the site address; and
- 2. The crane is to be lit in accordance with CAR Part 77 Appendix B; and
- 3. Cook Brothers Construction Limited is to contact Queenstown airport corporation (QAC), for issuing of a NOTAM to advise pilots of the crane as appropriate; and
- 4. Cook Brothers construction Limited is to advise CAA when the crane operating at the site address is no longer required Quote 24/77/11 (aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz).

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 30thth October 2023 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 30th April 2025.
