**NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Jones Road, Templeton,  
Christchurch Lat/Long 43 34 07 S 172 25 34 E.**

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Titan Cranes Limited notification of intention to operate a crane to lift a Mast at Jones Road, Templeton, Christchurch, reviewed an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

**DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE**

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is not to exceed a maximum height of 69.7m above ground level (AGL); and
2. The crane is to be lit as proposed by Titan Cranes Limited; and
3. Prior to the operation, Titan Cranes Limited is to provide Christchurch Airport (Attention: Ford Robertson) with the confirmed date, times and maximum height of the crane operation so that a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) can be issued for pilot awareness; and
4. Titan Cranes Limited is to notify CAA – Quote 24/77/26 ([aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz](mailto:aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz)) when the crane is lowered and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 5<sup>th</sup> January 2023 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 5<sup>th</sup> July 2025.
