

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 10 Te Kapua Drive, Mangere, Auckland.

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from, Hi- Lift Cranes Limited, notification of intention to erect a crane at 10 Te Kapua Drive, Mangere, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane is to be lit in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B; and
- 2. The crane is not to exceed 95m AGL; and
- 3. Prior to the crane operation, Hi-Lift Cranes Limited is to contact Auckland Airport Airfield Operations on 09 256 8990 (H24), email ross.cameron@aucklandairport.co.nz to notify the intended operation and request a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) is issued for the duration; and
- 4. Upon notification of commencement of the crane operation, Auckland Airport Airfield Operations is to issue a NOTAM for the duration; and
- 5. Prior to the crane operation, Hi-Lift Cranes Limited is to contact Aeropath NZ (Part77@aeropath.aero) Quote 23/77/47 to notify of the intended operation and request a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) is issued to raise the Circling Minima for the duration; and
- 6. Upon notification of commencement of the crane operation, Aeropath is to issue a NOTAM raising the NZAA minima for the duration; and
- 7. The crane is to be operated in hours of daylight only; and
- 8. At night the crane is to be lowered to remain below the obstacle limitation surface; and

- 9. Hi-Lift Cranes Limited is to follow any reasonable request from Auckland Airport for lowering the crane when in use; and
- 10. Hi-Lift Cranes Limited is to advise CAA (Quote 23/77/47 aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane is lowered and no longer in use; and
- 11. Hi-Lift Cranes Limited is to advise Auckland Airport Airfield Operations when the crane is lowered and no longer in use so that the NOTAM can be cancelled; and
- 12. Hi-Lift Cranes Limited is to ensure they advise Aeropath, Quote 23/77/47, when the crane is lowered and no longer in use so that the NOTAM can be cancelled.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 23rd June 2023 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
