

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 12 Market Street, Frankton, Queenstown.

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Cook Brothers Construction Limited notification of intention to operate a crane at 12 Market Street, Frankton, Queenstown, reviewed an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. Cook Brothers Construction Limited is to continue to liaise directly with Queenstown Airport for the operation of the crane; and
- 2. Queenstown Airport is to issue a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) for the duration of the crane operation for pilot awareness; and
- 3. The crane is not to exceed 18.5m AGL; and
- 4. The crane is to be lit as agreed with Queenstown Airport; and
- 5. Cook Brothers Construction Limited is to notify Queenstown Airport when the crane is lowered and no longer in use; and
- 6. Cook Brothers Construction Limited is to notify CAA (aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane is lowered and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on  $15^{th}$  March 2025.
