



**NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION:  
Titan Cranes Ltd – 292 Main South Road, Hornby, Christchurch.  
Position: 43 32 31.20 S 172 32 14.58 E**

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Hamish William McKoy, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Titan Cranes Ltd, notification of intention to operate a 78m high crane at 292 Main South Road, Hornby, Christchurch, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

**DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE**

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:


1. The tower crane at 292 Main South Road, Hornby, Christchurch is to be lit as proposed by Titan Cranes Ltd in their application Section 3 (c); and
2. The crane is not to exceed 104m AMSL; and
3. The crane will be operated during daylight hours only, and
4. Titan Cranes Ltd is to advise CAA (Quote 24/77/59 [aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz](mailto:aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz)) when the crane at the 292 Main South Road, Hornby, Christchurch site is removed.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 25 July 2024 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

*The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder*

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 10 June 2025.
