

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Mahurangi Forest, between Wellsford and Warkworth.

The mast is located at Lat / Long: 36 22 51.27 S 174 34 40.44 E

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Contact Energy Limited, notification of a re-assessment for an existing Met Tower at Mahurangi Forest, between Wellsford and Warkworth, reviewed an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that continued use of the Mast would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE, I HEREBY RE-ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions continue to be specific to this Determination:

- 1. Contact Energy Limited shall continue to ensure that the mast is lit and marked as specified in the Part 77 proposal dated 2nd December 2021; and
- 2. Contact Energy Limited is to notify CAA Quote 23/77/62 (aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the mast is eventually lowered and removed off site.
- 3. Contact Energy Limited is to notify Aeropath (Part77@aeropath.aero) when the mast has been lowered and removed off site so that this can be omitted from the EAD database and AIP as considered necessary.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 15th September 2023 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 15th March 2025.
