

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 313 – 343 Frankton Road, Queenstown

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Brosnan Construction Canterbury Limited, notification of intention to erect a crane structure at 313 – 343 Frankton Road, Queenstown, reviewed an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane is not to exceed a maximum height of 78m above ground level (AGL) at the site address; and
- 2. The crane is to be lit as stated in the proposal; and
- Brosnan Construction Canterbury Limited is to advise CAA and Queenstown Airport (Attention: Daniel Dodd) when the crane operating at the site address is no longer required – For CAA: Quote 24/77/12 to aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2023 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2025.
