

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Lattice Truss Tower at 98 Colyer Road, Awarua, Invercargill Position 46 30 19.53 S 168 22 59.68 E

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Stewart Family Holdings Limited, notification of intention to construct a lattice truss tower at 98 Colyer Road, Awarua, Invercargill, to be in position from May 2024 until May 2027, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The lattice truss tower at 98 Colyer Road, Awarua, Invercargill is to be lit as proposed by Stewart Family Holdings Limited in their application, in accordance with CAA Rule Part 77 Appendix B; and
- 2. The tower is not to exceed a height of 108.7m above mean sea level (AMSL); and
- 3. Stewart Family Holdings Limited is to advise CAA (Quote 24/77/57 <u>aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz</u>) when the tower at the 98 Colyer Road, Awarua, Invercargill site is dismantled.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 28 June 2024 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 28 December 2025
