

**NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 124–132 Halsey Street, Auckland.**

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Hawkins Limited notification of intention to operate a crane at 124–132 Halsey Street, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.


The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is to be lit with an appropriate obstacle light; and
2. Prior to expiry of this Determination, Hawkins Limited are to provide 30 days' notice (email: [aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz](mailto:aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) quote 22/77/78) for a request to extend the determination for 6 months until completion scheduled for end May 2024; and
3. Hawkins Limited is to advise the CAA (Quote 22/77/78 - [aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz](mailto:aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz)) when the crane operating at the Halsey Street site is lowered and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 29th July 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 29<sup>th</sup> January 2024.
