

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 16–20 Williamson Avenue, Grey Lynn, Auckland.

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Hamish William McKoy, Senior Technical Specialist, having received from Smith Cranes Limited notification of intention to operate a crane at 16–20 Williamson Avenue, Grey Lynn, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.


The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane shall be lit with an appropriate obstacle light in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B; and
- Smith Cranes Limited are to advise the CAA (Quote 22/77/44 - aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane operating at the Williamson Avenue site is lowered and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 1st April 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 1st October 2023 or when the crane is lowered and no longer in use.
