



NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 94 – 84 Marsh’s Road, Hornby, Christchurch.

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Head of Aeronautical Services, having received from Calder Stewart Plant Limited notification of intention to operate a crane at 94 – 84 Marsh’s Road, Hornby, Christchurch, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is to be lit with an appropriate obstacle light as stated in the Part 77 proposal; and
2. The crane is not to exceed a height of 59m above ground level (AGL); and
3. If practicable, the crane is to be lowered when not in use; and
4. Calder Stewart Plant Limited is to notify the CAA, (Quote 2025-00665 to aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane is removed off site and no longer required.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 27th June 2025 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 27th December 2026.
