

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 95 Willow Street, Tauranga.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from LT McGuinness Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane at 95 Willow Street, Tauranga, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a Hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE, I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane is to be lit in accordance with Rule Part 77 Appendix B; and
- 2. The crane is not to exceed 75m above ground level (AGL); and
- 3. When the crane is erected, LT McGuiness Limited is to notify Aeropath (Quote 2025-00509 to Part77@aeropath.aero) that the crane has been erected to include an approximate completion date; and
- 4. When the crane is lowered and no longer in use, LT McGuiness Limited is to notify Aeropath (Quote 2025-00509 to Part77@aeropath.aero) and request CAT A circling procedures be restored to normal; and
- 5. When the crane is lowered and no longer in use, LT McGuiness Limited is to notify CAA (Quote 2025-00509 to Aeronautical.Services@caa.govt.nz).

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 28th May 2025 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.



This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
