

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Southland Museum, Queens Park, Invercargill.

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Naylor Love Central Otago Limited, notification of intention to operate a mobile crane at Southland Museum, Queens Park, Invercargill, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. Prior to the operation of the crane, Invercargill Airport has agreed to arrange a planning meeting to include Airways ATC and Naylor Love Central Otago Limited to coordinate the crane lifting schedule and appropriate permissions for the raising and lowering the crane; and
2. Naylor Love Central Otago Limited is to provide Invercargill Airport the details needed to ensure that a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) is issued for each period of crane operation prior to the operation taking place; and
3. The Crane is to be lowered below the OLS when not in use; and
4. The Crane is to be lit in accordance with paragraph 3c of the proposal; and
5. The Crane operation is not to exceed a maximum elevation of 45m AGL; and
6. The crane operator is to follow all instructions from NZNV airport and ATC, as practicable, to ensure the safe operation of aviation activity at NZNV; and
7. When the crane is removed off site and no longer in use, Naylor Love Central Otago Limited is to notify CAA – Quote 2025-00243 to aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 28th May 2025 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
