

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Crane at 37 Westpoint Drive, Hobsonville, Auckland

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Dominion Constructors Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane at 37 Westpoint Drive, Hobsonville, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

## THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The cranes operating within the proposed area shall be lit with an appropriate obstacle light in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B; and
- Dominion Constructors Limited shall give RNZAF Base Operations (<u>AKBASEOPERATIONS@NZDF.MIL.NZ</u> ph. 09 417 7442) at least 48 hours' notice prior to commencing any Mobile and Tower crane ops so that a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) can be issued; and
- 3. Where practicable, Dominion Constructors Limited must lower the crane within 15mins of notification by Base Operations; and
- 4. Dominion Constructors Limited shall lower the Mobile cranes when not in use; and
- Dominion Constructors Limited shall advise the CAA (<u>aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz</u>) when all cranes operating at the Westpoint Drive site are no longer required; and

- 6. Dominion Constructors Limited shall advise the RNZAF Base operations (<u>AKBASEOPERATIONS@NZDF.MIL.NZ</u> ph. 09 417 7442) when the Tower crane operating at the Westpoint Drive site is lowered and no longer required; and
- 7. Dominion Constructors Limited shall advise the RNZAF Base operations (<u>AKBASEOPERATIONS@NZDF.MIL.NZ</u> ph. 09 417 7442) when the Mobile cranes operating at the Westpoint Drive site are no longer required.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 21st September 2021 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
