

**NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 42 Arena Avenue, Avenal, Invercargill.**

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Statesman Project Management Limited, notification of intention to operate a mobile crane at 42 Arena Avenue, Avenal, Invercargill, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. Prior to the operation of the crane, Invercargill Airport is to arrange a planning meeting to include Airways ATC and the crane operator to coordinate the lifting schedule; and
2. Invercargill Airport is to ensure that a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) is issued for each period of crane operation and to liaise with all operators prior to the operation taking place; and
3. Crane operation is limited to daylight hours only; and
4. Crane is to be lowered below the OLS when not in use; and
5. Crane operation is not to exceed a maximum elevation of 37m AGL; and
6. The crane operator is to follow all instructions from NZNV airport, as practicable, to ensure the safe operation of aviation activity at NZNV; and
7. Statesman Project Management Limited is to notify CAA – Quote 23/77/08 – [aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz](mailto:aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) – when the crane is removed off site and no longer in use.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 19th December 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
