

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Tower Cranes at 50-68 Cable St, Wellington

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from LT McGuiness Building Contractors, notification of intention to operate two tower cranes at a site at 50-68 Cable St, Wellington conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane shall be lit with an appropriate obstacle light in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B; and
- 2. LT McGuiness Building Contractors are to provide details of the crane operations to the Queen Wharf Heliport operator (GCH Aviation) and the Wellington Hospital Heliport operator (Capital and Coast District Health Board) for their awareness of the crane operation; and
- 3. LT McGuiness Building Contractors shall advise the CAA when the crane operating at the Cable St site is no longer required.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 28 April 2020 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 20 August 2021.
