

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: McIntosh Cranes – Crane at 23 The Cutting Way, Palmerstton North Airport.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from McIntsoh, notification of intention to operate a crane at 23 The Cutting Way, Plamerston North from 1 May 2020 until 24 December 2021, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

## THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane shall be lit with an appropriate obstacle light in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B; and
- 2. McIntosh Cranes are to provide details of the crane operations Aeropath to allow the promulgation of a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) alerting pilots and operators to the presence of the obstacle; and
- 3. McIntosh Cranes shall advise the CAA when the crane operating at the 23 The Cutting Way site is no longer required

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 5 May 2020 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
