

Notice of Objects and Activities Affecting Navigable Airspace – Structure discharging Efflux at 90 Browning Street, Tokoroa

The Director of Civil Aviation has received notification from Olam Food Ingredients Limited to construct a milk dryer plant that will discharge efflux to a height of 44m AGL (1277ft AMSL).

Pursuant to Civil Aviation Rule 77.17(a), the Director of Civil Aviation is conducting an aeronautical study to determine whether the specific proposal, if executed, will constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.
