



NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Hiway Geotechnical Limited Crane at Bayfair Shopping Centre Tauranga

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Hiway Geotechnical Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane and drill rig at Bayfair Shopping Centre, Tauranga, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane and drill rig are to be equipped with medium intensity obstacle lights, located at the highest points of the crane and drill rig in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B. The light must be operational at all times; and
2. The crane and drill rig is lowered below the OLS outside of daylight hours; and
3. The operator must comply with the procedures put forward by Tauranga airport at all times, and any other conditions imposed by Tauranga airport during the crane and drill rig operations; and
4. The crane operator must advise the CAA when the crane and drill rig is no longer in use and is dismantled.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 7th day of May 2018 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
