

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Smith Cranes Ltd - Luffing Crane for Malvina Project Wellington

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Smith Crane And Construction Ltd, notification of intention to operate a 76m high Luffing Crane at the Malvina Major Rest Home, Burma Road, Johnsonville, Wellington, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane is to be equipped with a medium intensity obstacle light, located at the highest point of the crane in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B. The light must be operational at all times.
- The crane operator must inform the CAA when the crane is no longer in use and is dismantled;

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 21 December 2017 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 24 June 2018
