

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Smith Crane And Construction Ltd- Tower Crane Christchurch Convention Centre Project

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Smith Crane And Construction Ltd, notification of intention to operate a 66 metre high crane at the Christchurch Convention Centre site at the intersection of Colombo and Gloucester Streets, Christchurch, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

In order to ensure that local flight operations are aware of the crane, the following conditions are applicable to the Determination:

- 1. The crane is to be equipped with a medium intensity obstacle light, located at the highest point of the crane in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B. The light must be operational at all times.
- 2. The crane operator must inform the CAA when the crane is no longer in use and is dismantled;

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 21 December 2107 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 1 December 2018.
