



NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Hawkins 2017 Ltd - Crane for new School of Medicine AKL University

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Hawkins 2017 Ltd, notification of intention to operate a 100 metre high crane at a site at 28 Park Avenue, Grafton, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane at the site must each be equipped with a medium intensity flashing red light located at the highest available point, in accordance with CAR Part 77, Appendix B. These lights must be operational at all times; and
- The crane must be equipped with a lighting system on the boom of the crane such that a helicopter approaching or departing from the Heliport can visually discern the whole length and orientation of the boom; and
- A NOTAM must be raised to inform pilots intending to use Auckland Hospital Heliport of the presence of the crane
- The proponent is to notify the CAA that the operation has ceased, as soon as possible after the crane has been dismantled; and

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 4 April 2018 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 31 October 2019.
