



NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Fulton Hogan Limited Civil-Increase Boom Length of Crawler Crane

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Fulton Hogan Limited Civil, notification of intention to increase the boom length of an existing crawler crane at a construction site in Huntly, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane is to be equipped with a flashing red light at the highest possible point on the crane;
- The CAA must be notified of the completion of the crane operation at the site within 5 days of its removal.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 23 February 2018 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 29 June 2018.
