

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Naylor Love Auckland Limited-Crane at 1-5 Taylors Road Morningside Auckland

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Naylor Love Auckland Limited, notification of intention to construct a crane at 1-5 Taylors Road, Morningside, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane is to be equipped with an obstacle light located at the highest point of the crane, in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B. The light must be operational at all times; and
- 2. The crane is to be lowered as much as practicable when not in use; and
- 3. Naylor Love Auckland Ltd must advise CAA when the crane is no longer in use and is dismantled.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2018 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 9<sup>th</sup> July 2019.
