

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Safari Construction Limited

Flat Top Crane at Site T21 Remarkables Park Queenstown

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Patrick Declan Smiddy, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Safari Construction Limited, notification of intention to erect a crane at Remarkables Park, Queenstown, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane is to marked and lit in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B; and
- Obstruction lighting is to be operated at all times of the day and night.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on the 11th day of February 2015 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
