- 1. Use a separate form for aeroplane, helicopter, or balloon licence.
- 2. A completed Fit and Proper Person Questionnaire, form <u>CAA 24FPP</u> or <u>CAA 24FPPDEC</u>, is required with this application. Refer to the 24FPP form for guidance on the appropriate form to be used.
- 3. Applicants must provide a physical address for service in New Zealand.
- 4. Aviation English Language Proficiency Assessment Credit Mandatory after 5 March 2008. Refer to CAA website, <u>How to</u> <u>be a pilot</u> and <u>AC61-1</u> for further information.
- 5. The UK CAA require individual licence holders who wish to have their EASA licence details released to the CAA of New Zealand to submit the appropriate verification <u>authorisation form</u> together with the associated fee to the UK CAA before such information will be released. Contact the <u>UK CAA</u> for information.
