Exemption from the Requirement in Civil Aviation Rule
CAR 43.151(a)

PURSUANT TO Section 37 of the Civil Aviation Act 1990,

I, Graeme Harris, Director of Civil Aviation, being satisfied that—

- (a) The action taken in having a review of airworthiness of a hot air balloon performed by a person qualified on that balloon type by an ICAO contracting State, is as effective as the requirement in CAR 43.151(a) that the review be performed by a person who holds an inspection authorisation issued under Part 66; and
(b) the risk to safety will not be significantly increased by the granting of this exemption,

HEREBY EXEMPT—

Persons who perform a Review of Airworthiness
on hot air balloon ZK-UCF

FROM—

the requirement in Civil Aviation Rule CAR 43.151(a) that a person must not perform a review of airworthiness for an aircraft unless that person holds an inspection authorisation issued under Part 66,

PROVIDED THAT—

- (a) the person performing the review is qualified on the balloon type by an ICAO contracting State, and
(b) no passengers are carried in the balloon for hire or reward.

This exemption shall remain in effect until 31 December 2018 unless withdrawn earlier in writing by the Director.
